Start with an Outline - Focus on Story Structure

This is the foundation of your speech!

The start:

Wow them! Open with something that will captivate the audience

The body:

- Supporting information
- Stories, facts, statistics...everything that lends credence to your introduction

The end:

 Call to action, summation of what you've talked about, thoughtful question for the audience, etc.



Write Your Script

Write your script

Make your tone conversational Create a blank
20-slide
PowerPoint
presentation

Cut / paste your script onto slides (words only for now)



Fine Tune Timing

Go to Slide Show/Rehearse Timings and start reading!





 At the end of your presentation, you will see a prompt telling you how long your narration was and asking if you want to save the new slide timings. Click "Yes."



On your first run-through, you'll notice that some slides go on for too long, others not long enough. Edit your speech by adding, deleting and rearranging text until reading each slide takes 13–14 seconds.







Design your Slides


Ignite presentations tend to contain large pictures, simple charts and graphs, and a minimal amount of text without any bullet points.

Sometimes, an Ignite presentation will have only one photo per slide.

Set your Slide Times & PRACTICE!



 Click on the Transitions tab on the Ribbon. Select Fade (#1, above). In the Timing group, deselect "On Mouse Click" and select "After." Type 15 in the box (#2, above). Then click "Apply to All (#3, above).
